What is Uncountable Noun?

Uncountable nouns are the backbone of our vocabulary as they convey essential concepts allowing us to talk about things we cannot count! Imagine a jar full of milk – you cannot count the number of one milk, two milk and so on.

How to Identify and Use the Uncountable Nouns?

- Articles such as "a," and "an," are not used with the uncountable nouns.
- If you could not count the individual items present then it is an uncountable noun. (e.g., tea, water; anger, beauty).
- The substances, qualities, and abstract ideas are often considered to be uncountable.
