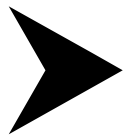

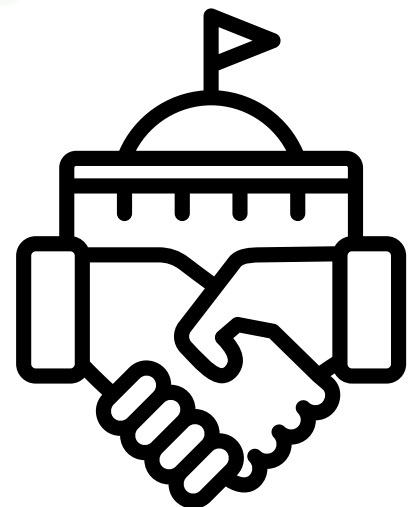

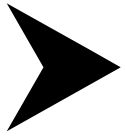
2. The expansion of (A) private-sector space activities (B) is significantly changing the dynamics (C) of space exploration and utilization (D) in the field.
