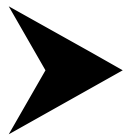
English Unseen Passage for Class 7 Students

However, Lila soon realized that she had to use her gift wisely, as not everything should be created without effort. She learned that hard work is just as important as talent.



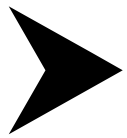
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Questions:

5. Hard work is important because it complements talent and effort is necessary for meaningful achievements.



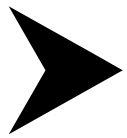
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Unseen Passage 8: The Science Fair
