Answers:

- 1. Yes "myself" adds emphasis
- 2. No "herself" is reflexive (she is the subject and object)
- 3. Yes "themselves" adds emphasis
- 4. No "ourselves" is reflexive (they are helping themselves)
- 5. Yes "himself" adds emphasis
