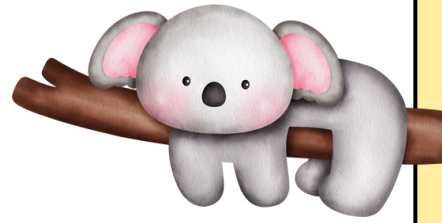


Noun Phrase Worksheet

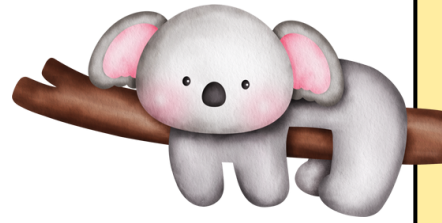
Set B: Instructions: Rewrite the sentences by replacing the underlined part with a noun phrase.

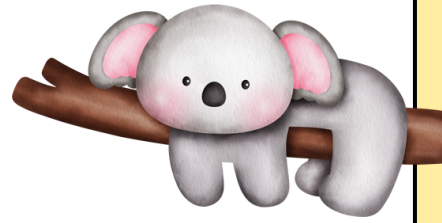
